

EIP y CLM: Grants for Spanish courses at the CLM (Language Centre, University of Granada)

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Introduction

The Advisory Council for Doctoral Schools (CAED) agreed, at the meeting held on the 5th November, 2020, to open a call for grants for the following Spanish courses:

- Extensive Spanish course (online)

and

- Courses in Spanish as a Foreign Language (CELE)

Beneficiaries

These grants are meant for non-Spanish speaking students enrolled in any of the doctoral programmes of the University of Granada. Students whose periods of stay at our university are not compatible with the dates of the courses offered can choose to attend either to only the first part or the second part of the courses.

Budget

In 2022 the doctoral schools will cover 40% of the cost of the courses. A maximum of 3000€ will be allocated to finance these courses.

Selection criteria and deadlines

There is no deadline for this call, the Advisory Council for Doctoral Schools will act as the selection committee. The selection will be made on a first come first served basis, prioritizing those submissions made by students under a cotutelle agreement.
