y entre las 10 primeras de España

La UGR alcanza posiciones muy destacadas en algunos indicadores del ranking, como la posición 34 del mundo en redes de investigación internacionales o la 192 en reputación académica

La Universidad de Granada (UGR) ha escalado casi cien puestos en la edición 2024 del QS World University Rankings, que clasifica a 1500 universidades de más de 100 países y se acaba de publicar.

La institución granadina, que en años anteriores venía ocupando las posiciones entre el 450 y 550 del mundo, en esta última edición ha subido casi 100 puestos situándose en la posición 403 del mundo (27% del top mundial), la décima de España y la primera de toda Andalucía.






Once you enroll, apply for an appointment at the virtual office to go to one of the TUI points to get your student card. You only need your ID/passport, the same you used for the enrolment.





FAQs INCOMING Students



Here you will find information on procedures and deadlines of the International Postgraduate School for incoming mobility students, who are linked to the international mobility programs of Master's students, such as: Erasmus+: Erasmus, Erasmus+: International Dimension, Free Mobility, etc. All information regarding call-ups and selections is handled by the <u>Vice-Rector for Internationalisation</u>. If you don't find the information you were looking for, don't hesitate on <u>contacting us</u>

➤ Frequently asked questions

How can I apply at the University of Granada?	Before applying online you must make sure that your home university has nominated you to the University of Granada. Whatever your profile, all international students who have been nominated by their home university and who wish to carry out an international mobility study stay at the University of Granada must make an <i>online application</i> prior to the study period.
If I am nominated for a Master's degree, can I include Bachelor's degree courses?	Yes, but you will have to make two online applications (one for bachelor's degree and one for master's degree) and indicate the subjects to be included in each of the levels of study. The maximum number of credits of Bachelor studies to be included will be 6 (nominations of a semester) or 12 (nominations of a complete course).
What are the deadlines to apply online?	The deadlines for the online application are dictated by the International Relations Office . As a general rule, the term for the stay in the first semester or full course is from April 1 to May 15 and the term to stay in the second semester is from October 1 to 31.
What are the language admission requirements?	They are those established in the Interinstitutional Agreement between the universities. Unless the student is in any of the exemption grounds, he/she must certify at least the level required according to the language of teaching of the subjects indicated in their study agreement. The exemptions to the previous linguistic requirements and the certificates of linguistic competence accepted by the University of Granada can be consulted <i>here</i> .
How do I make the Learning Agreement?	It must be agreed with the Mobility Coordinators of the Universities of origin and destination.
When do I have to enroll at the University of Granada?	Once your study agreement is signed, we will proceed ex officio to enroll you in the subjects included and we will send you a confirmation email once it is carried out.
When will I get the Transcript of Records?	Once the mobility is completed and all grades appear in the student's file, we will proceed to email the transcript to the home university and the student.











SPECIFIC MASTER'S DEGREES TIMETABLES






INTERNATIONALIZATION TUTORS

PAPERWORK

- 1. Certificate of arrival/ Certicado de llegada. Signed by ourselves in our office (EIP) and today here. (We can not sing by email!!!)
- 2. Learning agreement/ Acuerdo de estudios.
- Incoming students cannot attend more than half the credits needed for the given degree.
- Languages courses could not be included.
- Bachelor courses can be added, please contact with the Faculty or School in charge. (<u>Two courses maximum</u>)

 Those ones are directly dealt by our colleagues from the Faculties, Centers and Schools from all over the University of Granada. Write us to epinternacional@ugr.es for further details.
- Both Table A and B must be completed.
- 3. During the mobility / Modificación del acuerdo de estudios.* later on explained.
- 4. Certificate of end of the mobility/ Certificado final de estancia. Signed by ourselves in our office (EIP).
- 5. Transcript of Records/ Certificado académico.
 - Bachelor's degree certificates are provided by the responsible faculty/school.
 - Our office will automatically send the master's degree certificates to your home university.



HOW TO MODIFY YOUR LEARNING AGREEMENT?

- 1. Check your courses
- 2. Consult with your supervisors (Home and UGR) for academic advice
- 3. Send your L.A. During Mobility form to epinternacional@ugr.es, correctly filled out and signed by your home university and you.
- 4. Please bear in mind that you are allowed 2 modifications.
- 5. According to master's Degrees administrative procedures, changes should be registered by 29th November.






